1. Sibling Scholarship Scheme

Criteria

- Scholarship of **20% on tuition fee**
- Applicable for the **immediate sibling** of existing/former students
- Proof of relation required

Eligible Courses

- Diploma Engineering
 - Diploma in Hotel Management
 - BBA, MBA, BHM
 - B.A, BCA, MCA
 - B.Sc, M.Sc
 - B.Tech, M.Tech

2. Employee Scholarship Scheme

Criteria

This Scholarship Scheme is open to children / immediate sibling of permanent employees working under JIS Group.

Conditions:

- Employee must have minimum **3 years continuous service** in group as of 30th June of the concerned Academic Session
- Employee must be on regular payroll
- Only **one child/immediate sibling** can avail scholarship

- Applicable for students who completed degree/diploma from JIS Group institutions and take admission again under JIS Group

 - B.Tech → MBA

4. Diploma to B.Tech (Lateral) Scholarship

Criteria

- Scholarship of **₹60,000**
- ₹10,000 per semester
- Applicable to students who completed 3-year Diploma Engineering from JIS Group institutions

Eligible Course

- Diploma → B.Tech (Lateral)

B.Tech to M.Tech Scholarships

5. Full Tuition Fee Waiver for B.Tech Toppers

Criteria

- 4-year B.Tech topper from any JIS institution
- Must pursue M.Tech under JIS Group

Benefit

- Full tuition fee waiver

Eligible Course

- B.Tech → M.Tech

6. Alumni Scholarship for M.Tech

Criteria

- Student completed B.Tech from JIS Group
- Takes admission into M.Tech under JIS Group

Benefit

- 20% tuition fee waiver
- AND assistantship of ₹3000/month

Note

- M.Tech Civil Engineering students are **not eligible** for stipend

7. Scholarship & Assistantship for M.Tech Students

Criteria

- External students with **DGPA 7.0 or above**

Benefits

- 20% tuition fee waiver
- ₹10,000 per semester
- ₹3000/month assistantship

Note

- M.Tech Civil Engineering students not eligible for stipend

8. MBA Scholarship

Criteria & Benefits

Marks in Last Qualifying Exam	Scholarship
70% and above	30% tuition fee waiver
60% and above	20% tuition fee waiver

9. Scholarship Scheme for Students of Tripura

Criteria

- Applicable for B.Tech Lateral Entry admissions
- Available in:
 - JIS College of Engineering
 - Guru Nanak Institute of Technology
 - Dr. Sudhir Chandra Sur Degree Engineering College
 - Narula Institute of Technology (except Civil Engineering)
 - JIS University

Conditions

1. Candidate must be resident of Tripura with valid Aadhaar
2. Must satisfy qualification requirements for B.Tech lateral admission
3. Scholarship:
 - ₹7000 each for 3rd & 4th semesters
 - ₹6500 each from 5th to 8th semester
4. Student must not have any year lag

Eligible Course

- B.Tech (Lateral)

10. Sikh Scholarship

Criteria

- Sikh students may apply for **50% freeship/scholarship on tuition fees**

Process

- Student applies to Gurudwara first
- After receiving 50% fee cheque, submit to institution accounts department
- Submit scholarship application with receipt

Important Notes

- Scholarship applies only on tuition fees
- Other fees must be paid by students
- Applicable from 2nd semester onwards

Eligible Courses

- All Courses

General Scholarship Rules

Important Conditions

- A student can avail **only one scholarship**
 - Scholarships cannot be combined
 - Students already receiving scholarship/financial aid from govt/private agencies are not eligible simultaneously

Withdrawal of Scholarship

Scholarship may be withdrawn if:

1. Student fails/reappears/detention occurs
 2. Student leaves course midway
 3. Attendance shortage or disciplinary issues occur
 4. Parent employee leaves JIS services
 5. Board of Governors decides otherwise

M.Tech Scholarship/Assistantship Eligibility Rules

Applicable for regular M.Tech students.

Key Conditions

1. Scholarship valid for maximum 24 months
2. Student leaving midway must refund scholarship amount
3. External funded students may also apply
4. Student must devote 8–10 hours/week for teaching or research assistance
5. Scholarship renewed semester-wise based on performance
6. Review committee verifies eligibility every semester
7. Minimum SGPA required: **8.0**

Publication Requirements

1st Year

- At least one international conference paper
- At least one SCI indexed journal paper

2nd Year

- At least one SCI indexed journal paper with impact factor > 1.0
- At least one international conference paper

Timeline Requirements

- 3rd Semester: SCI paper publication between 1 July – 31 October
- 4th Semester: International conference paper between 1 January – 31 March

12.

Publication of the student must be in the name of the institute from where he is pursuing his M.Tech & receiving stipend.

13.

The students may publish his Journal/conference paper jointly with the faculty of the concerned institution but not with any other student of the same institution. If he/she publishes any paper jointly with the student of the same institution the said publication will not be considered for renewal of stipend.

14.

The student must abide by the existing LEAVE RULE of the institute for the M.Tech Programme.

15.

As per this rule, an M.Tech Student is eligible for 30 days of leave in an academic year. Any absence over and above the prescribed limit of admissible leave shall entail deduction from the assistantship, besides other actions as may be decided by the Institute, which may be up to the extent of discontinuation of Stipend.

16.

The student must abide by CONDUCT RULES of the institute for the M.Tech Programme. If any disciplinary action is taken by the Institute authority against a student, his/her Stipend shall be discontinued from the date of effect of such order.

How to apply:

Students are required to fill up the Scholarship Form available in website or with the Institute's Admission cell.

Note:

Applicants will be judged by the Scholarship Committee and final decisions will be taken as per the recommendations of the Committee.

Freeship*	Students with poor financial background are eligible to apply for freeship. Apart from direct applications recommendations from political leaders are also considered under this category. Recommendation: Check point can be introduced: such as results, attendance, behaviour, social media appearance etc. Freeship will only be considered from 2nd semester onwards. We need to freeze the percentage below 50% (may be 20%) on the tuition fees as the no of applications have been increased due to pandemic situation in 2020. Students who lost their father during the courses get 50% freeship on their tuition fees from colleges as per MAKAUT Rules.	—	—

Approval process:

All the applications must be processed through a physical enquiry and proper recommendation of the HOIs.

Basic scrutiny has to be done at the college level.

Only valid applications should be sent to the HO for final approval of the committee.

After getting the final approval all the applications will send back to office of HOI of the colleges along with a list.

Committee may provide the same list mentioning names, course, session and the percentage of freeship to the accounts department for final billing in the ERP.

Important:

HOI or Committee has the authority to revoke the freeship for any misconduct of the student.

Renewal of the freeship of every student may be introduced.

What is the process?

Referring student of JIS Group will complete the online form. The referral student (new student) as well as the referring student will receive an email confirmation of the submitted referral form after the admission committee verifies that the referral student has not enquired earlier or has already not applied with JIS Group of Institution at the point of time referral was made.

Once the referral student completes their first semester email the Admissions office. Ensure the criteria below are met to get your award issued. Also attach the email confirmation received from the admission department to process your award.

Criteria & Rules:

Program is open to the current students and alumni of JIS Group.

Applicants cannot refer themselves.

The referred student (new student) must enrol within 12 months of the referral form being received by the JIS Group admission team.

Referral forms will not be processed if the university has an earlier enquiry or application from the referred student (for any intake or program).

Institute may or may not reply / confirm back to the referring student in case the Institute already has an earlier enquiry or application from the referred student. In such cases the referring student should consider that the referred student enquiry or application was already with the university.

If more than one referral is received for a prospective student the first one received will be recognized. A maximum of two referrals per student and alumni of JIS Group will be awarded. However there is no limit on the total number of referrals which a student or alumni of JIS Group can make. After the referral student completes six months of enrolment (first semester), the referring student/alumni of JIS Group receives the award.

The referring student must be enrolled with JIS Group at time of reward.

The referring alumni must be able to produce his enrolment number / I-Card. Gift card can be from Amazon or any other retailer or bank. Gift card can be redeemed for making any purchase on the retailer or bank website up to the total value of the gift card.
